We welcome those of you at the beginning of your visual art journey as well as those of you who are well along in your chosen media and interested in developing your own paintings and drawings while in a group setting.



The Dauphin Art Group is one of the oldest groups ongoing at the Watson Art Centre, where we are an affiliate member with studio space in the basement. Dr. Vernon Watson, whom the Arts Centre is named after, was the first to offer painting and drawing instruction to people from this area in the 1960's.

Art Workshop and Membership Fees

The cost for each instructed workshop is \$65.00 for members of The Dauphin Art Group, or \$75.00 for non-members. Membership is \$10.00 per annum, due January of each year.
