The Crocus Quilters Guild is an inclusive group of individuals interested in the fabric art of quilting. The membership is made up of all levels of quilters from beginner through experienced. We have monthly meetings that include a little business, some show and tell of members' finished items, and a presentation about a new technique, pattern, or quilting tool. We end our meetings with coffee and snacks while visiting and taking a closer look at all the neat show and tell items.

We have a large library of tools, quilting patterns, and books that members can access free of charge. On the day of the meetings, the Fire Hall is open for those who like to work in a collaborative environment.

As a guild, we create numerous "Comfort Quilts" each year that we use to distribute to individuals or groups who may benefit by their comfort. They are created in a variety of ways from each member making blocks to contribute to the whole or using donated fabric and backings. Each is given out as needed and overseen by the Comfort Quilt Committee.

Un-Finished Object Saturdays (UFO Days) are usually once per month and are a time when anyone who likes to get away from home to focus on projects can take the time to be creative along with others. This is also a time when we can work on some of our charity quilts.

Each year we host an optional "challenge". Each person may receive a specific fabric, theme, or the like and they are to create whatever project they want if it follows their given criteria (theme, size, etc). Each participant votes on their favourite and the winner chooses the next year's challenge theme. The finished pieces hang at the Dauphin Public Library for the summer.
